



2015 Detroit CoC Point-in-Time Count

All Data Report

July 20, 2015

The Detroit Continuum of Care (CoC) conducted a one night Point-in-Time (PIT) count of people who were experiencing homelessness in Detroit, Hamtramck, and Highland Park on January 28, 2015. This count provides a snapshot of the number of people who were experiencing homelessness in our community on that one night. This report provides the full set of data reported to HUD for the 2015 PIT.
