

The Detroit Continuum of Care (CoC) conducted a one night Point-in-Time (PIT) count of people who were experiencing homelessness in Detroit, Hamtramck, and Highland Park on January 27, 2016. This count provides a snapshot of the number of people who were experiencing homelessness in our community on that one night.
